

# Can I get a second Bachelor's Degree?

If you have earned one bachelor's degree, you can apply to enroll in a second bachelor's degree program that is a different major from your first degree. You would be required to meet all major and prerequisite course requirements for the second degree. This would include completing [at least 30 additional hours](#) of credit at CSU-Global (for the second degree).

Your first bachelor's degree must be conferred in order to apply for a second degree program. When you are eligible to apply, please contact our Enrollment team ([admissions@csuglobal.edu](mailto:admissions@csuglobal.edu)) for more information. They can provide more information on which degree programs are available to you and will have you complete an *Alumni Graduate Program Application form* through the Document Center of your student portal. Because you must allow time for your first bachelor's [degree to be conferred](#) before beginning the second, you should be prepared to take at least 1 term off before beginning courses.
