Freshman Student Policies

If you are enrolled at CSU-Global and are considered a Freshman student, you can expect the following restrictions on your enrollment

- Cannot register in overlapping terms
- Cannot enroll in 400 level coursework
- Cannot self-register

First-time freshman students are required to take the following four courses in their first four terms. Students can take any 100, 200, or 300 level course with one of the following courses during their first four terms.

- 1. ORG100: Navigating Organizations and Change
- 2. ENG101: Composition I
- 3. HUM101: Critical Reasoning
- 4. ENG102: Composition II

Once you have completed 24 credits, the freshman hold will be removed at the end of that trimester. Please work with your Student Success Counselor to discuss your degree plan and schedule your classes.
