- 1. Applicants must be able to supply adequate proof that they are one of the following:
 - 1. Active Duty or Reserve/Guard U.S. Military Servicemember
 - 2. An Honorably Discharged or Separated Veteran
 - 3. A spouse of an Active Duty or Reserve/Guard U.S. Military Servicemember
 - 4. A spouse of a Honorably Discharged or Separated Veteran
 - 5. A dependent of an Active Duty or Reserve/Guard U.S. Military Servicemember
 - 6. A dependent of a Honorably Discharged or Separated Veteran
- 2. Applicants should contact their education office to determine if military benefits can be used in conjunction with scholarship awards. If a student is receiving active TA or VA benefits, the benefits may be impacted if selected as a scholarship winner.
- 3. Maximum scholarship value is applied to tuition charges or fees for up to 6 undergraduate credits or 6 graduate credits in the CSU Global or CBE/PLA alternative credit options.
