

Critical Thinking Assignments

There are several ways to submit an assignment:

- Click on **Modules** (located on the left-hand side of Canvas), followed by the corresponding module for the week **OR**
- Click on **Assignment** on the left hand side of Canvas and choose the assignment from there
- Click on **Grades** on the left hand side of Canvas then select the assignment you are looking to submit

Once you've found the assignment you want to submit, simply click the blue "Submit Assignment" button on the top right hand side of the page

On the Upload tab:

1. Click on the box that says **Choose File** and then select your assignment from wherever you saved it on your computer.
2. You'll know that your document has uploaded because the name will be listed next to the Choose File box.
3. Once you have selected the assignment, be sure to add any other necessary files and comments you want to send to the instructor
4. Click the box agreeing to the submission pledge
5. Click **Submit Assignment**
