## Provisional Requirements for Undergraduate Students

To be eligible for full admission, provisionally admitted undergraduate students are required to:

- Complete nine (9) credit hours within their first two consecutive trimesters
- Earn and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher at the end of the second trimester
- Earn an *cumulative* course completion rate of 66.66% or higher at the end of the second trimester

*Provisional reviews will run at the end of your second trimester. If you are not meeting the standards above, you will be withdrawn.*

## Provisional Requirements for Graduate Students

- To be eligible for full admission, provisionally admitted graduate students are required to:
  - Complete six (6) credit hours within their first two consecutive trimesters
  - Earn and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher at the end of their second trimester
  - Earn an *cumulative* course completion rate of 66.66% or higher at the end of their second trimester

*Provisional reviews will run at the end of your second trimester. If you are not meeting the standards above, you will be withdrawn.*

**If you do not meet provisional requirements and you are withdrawn from the university you will need to wait 30 days before you are eligible to apply for re-admission.**
