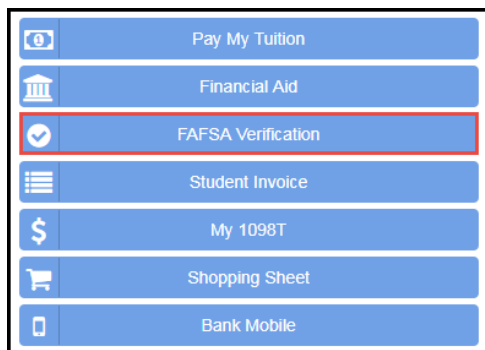


What does it mean if I'm selected for verification?

The Department of Education selects a random sample of students for a [FAFSA](#) review process called verification. The purpose is to find and resolve errors or conflicting information entered into the FAFSA. If you have been selected for verification, no worries! At CSU-Global, the verification process has been streamlined and now takes place through the [Verification Portal](#), which you can access through the student portal by clicking on the My Account and Financial Aid tab at the top followed by FAFSA Verification:



If this is your first time logging into the Verification Portal, you will need to create a new account. You'll want to enter your information exactly as it was entered into the FAFSA. You will be instructed to use your CSU-Global email address and will be able to enter the Verification portal using single sign-on in the future, as long as you first sign into the Student Portal.
