Can I take graduate level courses?

You are only eligible to take graduate level courses (500-level) if:

- You have completed a bachelor's degree AND
- You have been admitted into a graduate program OR
- You have been admitted into a graduate level certificate of completion program OR
- You have been accepted into an undergraduate dual enrollment program (please note that there are no current dual enrollment programs being offered)

Undergraduate students enrolled in a regular B.S. degree program are not eligible to take graduate level courses even to fulfill elective credit requirements.
