Do I have to include my parents' information on my FAFSA?

If you are a considered to be adependent student, you must include your parents' information on yourFAFSA application. Generally, students under the age of 24 are considered dependent unless they have one of the following exceptions:

- Married
- Active duty military service or a veteran
- Support more than 50% of children or other dependents
- Parents are deceased
- Emancipated minor
- Homeless or at risk of being homeless.
- Working on a Master's or doctorate program at the beginning of the 18/19 school year

If the FAFSA application determines you are an "independent" student, you are not required to provide any parent information.
