

# Mobile App - Permissions

The CSU Global Mobile App does have default permission settings after being downloaded. Below is a list of what the app may need to access on the user's phone:

- Calendar (iOS/Android) - to save classes/assignments to calendar
- Notifications (Android) - to send push notifications
- Location/GPS (iOS/Android) - used for directions in maps (not used with CSU-Global mobile app)
- Phone (iOS/Android) - to place calls from the phone
- Camera (iOS/Android) - save images from the image gallery
- Wifi (Android) - to pull content vs cell
- Device ID (Android) - to register the device for push notifications

Android and iOS users do have the ability to manually restrict these permissions, from the device, after the app has been installed. Below are articles on different ways to do this based on the platform:
