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2021-22 Verification Requirements

If you were selected for Verification on your 2021-22 FAFSA, then you may have been asked to submit a Tax Return Transcript from your **2019** taxes (or your parent's/spouse's 2019 taxes). If you/your parent/spouse were <u>not</u> required to file 2019 taxes, you will need to provide additional documents to complete your verification.

- **One** of the following items directly from the IRS:
 - Verification of Non-Filing Letter
