NDS Students Using Military Benefits

If you are a student in a non-degree seeking status and using VA benefits, there is important information you should know about your benefit eligibility.

Basic NDS Benefit Eligibility:

The only circumstance in which we can certify NDS courses (Undergrad OR Grad) is if a student is pursuing a degree at another institution and the credits will be transferring over to that institution.

The home school will need to provide what is called a *Parent Letter* to CSU Global's Military Benefits Department (military.benefits@csuglobal.ed) confirming that the courses being taken will transfer in and are required for the degree program. If a student it utilizing Voc Rehab benefits, rather than a parent letter, the Voc Rehab counselor approves these courses and will send CSU Global a 28-1905/Tungsten PO allowing for invoicing of the courses.

Additional Information:

- NDS students are not eligible for tuition discounts
- If a parent letter is received, students still must also:
 - Complete Military Information Form
 - Provide Certificate of Eligibility or VR&E PO
