 councils, evidence of leading initiatives that promote the well-being of their community, or any other activity
 that demonstrates community advocacy.
- Recipients are subject to all institutional scholarship terms and conditions.
- Scholarship funds can only be applied to courses that fulfill a degree requirement (core, specialization, or elective).
- Open to both undergraduate and graduate degree-seeking students.
- Academic performance, academic progress, financial need, and other consideration factors may be utilized
 during the scholarship review process. It is recommended that applicants have a Free Application for Federal

- Maximum scholarship value is applied to tuition charges and fees for up to 24 undergraduate credits or 12 graduate credits in CSU Global courses.
