Depending on your chosen finance option you will have certain documents you will need to complete and submit.

For financial aid in general you will need to submit:

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), Entrance Counseling, and a Master Promissory Note
 - These items can be completed at <https://studentaid.gov/>
 - You will be notified via your CSU Global email if additional documents are needed

For employer reimbursement or third party payments you will need to submit:

- Tuition Deferment Agreement
 - This can be accessed via your student portal under My Documents

For Military Benefits you will need to submit:

- Military Information Form
 - This can be accessed via your student portal under My Documents
 - You will be notified via your CSU Global email of the additional documents depending on the benefit being used.

If you are Self-Pay:

- Payment is due no later than the first day of class. You will receive an email via your CSU Global email once your tuition charges have been posted to your student account

You can always log into your CSU Global Student Portal and click on **My Account & Financial Aid** to see your personal student finance information. Remember to regularly check your CSU Global email for all finance related notifications.
