### Eligibility Requirements

Membership is open to both **undergraduate and graduate students** (including both online and on-campus learners). To be eligible for an invitation, a student must meet at least **one** of the following criteria:

- **GPA Requirement:** A cumulative GPA of **3.0 or higher** with at least **6 completed credit hours**.
- **Academic Honors:** Inclusion on the **Dean's or President's List** during Spring 2025 or the most recent academic term.

### Invitation Frequency

Invitations to join the SCLA are issued **annually**. Qualified students will receive an invitation via their student email account during the primary recruitment cycle.

### Membership Fees & Payment Options

The SCLA requires a **one-time membership fee of \$95**. This fee grants lifetime access to the society's resources; there are no recurring annual dues.
